

Upper Room Missional Grants

Process:

1. Fill out an application (see page 2)
2. A small group of people will review your application and will let you know if Upper Room can support your request. (Applications will be reviewed during the first week of each month.)
3. If your request for a grant is approved, we will connect you with a missional mentor
 1. We would like you to meet with this person 3 times
 2. Missional mentors are here to help you pursue your vision. They will take time to listen to your thoughts and ideas and ask questions. They are not 'experts' or people with all the answers, but people who want to cheer you on and help you!
 3. He/she will give you the requested funds from Upper Room at your first meeting.
4. Go and love people!
5. Take some pictures or a video, or write down what you have experienced and let us know what God is doing in and through you!

Guidelines:

- Missional grants are to be used to financially support your missional movement into the world as you love, serve and spend time with others in the way that God has called you
- Missional grants are intended to assist you in covering a portion of the costs connected to caring for and spending time with others.
- Missional grants are for people who consider the Upper Room to be their home church community.

Applicants will commit to:

- Using the funds as indicated on the application form
- Meeting with a missional mentor 3 times
- Providing at least one update to Upper Room
- Considering ways to connect other Upper Room community members into what you are doing
